Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Wessex Lifts Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Wessex Lifts has not previously assessed or reported its greenhouse gas emissions.

All scope categories (Scope 1, 2 and included Scope 3 sources) are estimated (speculative). These estimates will be verified in Q1 2026 by a third-party auditor.

The baseline year and current emissions are considered the same, since there are no earlier assessments.

Progress against these targets will be reported by Q1 2026 as indicated above.

Carbon Reduction Projects

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since inception. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equates to circa. 100 tCO₂e, a 33% reduction against our initial calculations (not included against our baseline, as this has been an approximate calculation carried out in 2024). These measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

- Certification and ongoing auditing against ISO 14001, with our Environmental Champion, Production Manager Paul Wheadon, responsible for implementation of our Environmental Management System.
- Deployment of our INFOR Integrated ERP System to streamline operations, reduce duplication, and minimise paper usage.
- Implementation of Fleetmatics vehicle tracking across our vans to reduce emissions by optimising routes, limiting idling, and discouraging non-business journeys.
- Ongoing renewal of our fleet with more efficient vehicles, including the introduction of four electric vehicles, with further expansion planned.
- Enhanced on-site and office energy efficiency, such as use of LED lighting, equipment switch-off policies, and redesigned hydraulic lift components requiring less energy and fluid.
- Waste minimisation and recycling measures, including segregation of recyclable materials, reduction of packaging waste through collaboration with suppliers, and use of tablets for engineers to eliminate unnecessary paper.
- Reducing to one site by 2028, negating the need for energy consumption.
- Limiting outsourcing mid process to reduce vehicle usage on the roads.

Looking forward, we are committed to further reducing our emissions through:

- Replacing the remaining internal combustion engine fleet with hybrid or electric vehicles, subject to operational suitability.
- Appointment of a specialist external auditor to calculate our emissions with full accuracy, ensuring transparent reporting by Q1 2025.
- Formal alignment with recognised initiatives, including a planned commitment to the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi), supporting our pathway to net zero.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
